

TELEHEALTH CONSENT FORM

What is telehealth?

Telehealth is a technology through which healthcare professionals, physicians and therapists can remotely provide necessary services by using interactive videoconferencing.

You can talk to your provider from any place by using phone, computer or any other device which allows videoconferencing. You will not be required to come to the clinic.

Confidentiality

Therapists would use a videoconferencing platform to provide telehealth that is designed to protect your privacy.

All the visits done through telehealth will not be recorded and will be done in a secure environment where no one else can hear or see you.

Patient rights

Patient can withdraw from telehealth visits at any time and this will not affect any future treatment. Patient can switch to clinic outpatient visits at any time as our clinic remain open at regular office hours.

Risk and benefits

Patient can get therapy services in their home without travelling to the clinic, maintaining social distancing as required at this time.

Although, it will be different from an in-person visit as patient and therapist will not be in the same room and only verbal commands can be given.

I authorize Chicago Rehabilitation Services to provide physical therapy services through telehealth. I understand possible risks and benefits, and other aspects of telehealth explained above.
